

The Latin America and Caribbean Seismological Commission (LACSC) is pleased to invite the entire geophysical community of the planet to its II Regional Assembly, which will be held in San José, Costa Rica, from the 20th to the 22nd of June 2016. LACSC is one of four Regional Commissions of the International Association of Seismology and Physics of the Earth Interior (IASPEI). IASPEI one of eight International Associations of the International Union of Geodesy and Geophysics (IUGG).

This second assembly of LACSC aims to bring together scientists from all over the world and from many different geophysical fields. We invite theoretical seismologists, instrumentalists, volcano seismologists, paleoseismologists, earthquake engineers, seismological software programmers, crustal deformation geodesists, seismic source modelers, seismological instrumentation developers, seismic tomographers and any other geophysicists interested in contributing or learning about the future of seismology.

This scientific event will be hosted by both the Costa Rica Academy of Sciences (ANC), the IUGG adhering institution, as well as by the National University (UNA), home of the Costa Rica Volcanological and Seismological Observatory (OVSICORI-UNA).

There are some some exceptions for visa requirement for ordinary passports for citizens of the countries that need visa to enter Costa Rica:

There are some exceptions for visa requirement for ordinary passports for citizens of the countries that need visa to enter Costa Rica:

- a) The nationals of the countries that have already a B1-B2 or D type visa to enter the United States of America, Canada, the countries of the European Union and /or Schengen visa, stamped in their passport, valid during the stay in Costa Rica, will be able to enter Costa Rica without a consular/restricted visa. The stay granted will be a maximum of 30 days. The Passport must be valid for at least six months.
- b) Nationals with a tourism visa to enter Japan and valid for at least six months (from the date of entry to Costa Rica), stamped in their passport, will be able to enter Costa Rica without a consular/restricted visa.
- c) Nationals with permanent residence (not as a refugee), a student visa, a work visa in the United States and/or any country of the European Union and Canada, do not need a visa to enter Costa Rica. This type of visa must be stamped in the passport, and must be valid for at least six months, counted from the day of arrival in Costa Rica. The stay granted will be a maximum of 30 days. The passport must be valid for at least six months.
- d) The nationals of the countries located in the third and fourth group who have a legal residence with a minimum of six months in countries of the first group that are not in the exceptionsof the preceding paragraph, need a visa. The six months period is from the day of entry to Costa Rica.

TRANSIT VISA: In case you need a transit visa on your travel to Costa Rica, please contact directly the Consulate of the country where you need the visa.



Yellow Fever Vaccination Requirements

If you are traveling to Costa Rica from the following countries, you will need an "International Certificate of Vaccination against Yellow Fever":

Benin, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, DemocraticRepublic of Congo, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Liberia, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Sudan, Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Republic of Guyana and Venezuela.

You can only travel to Costa Rica ten days after the shot.



Travel and medical insurance

All participants travelling are responsible for having valid travel and medical insurance covering the period of stay in Costa Rica


Security Measures





Basic security measures are suggested for all participants:
